LUIS F. ORTIZ

Pianist Luis F. Ortiz made his international debut with a 2010 recital in Miraflores, Peru. Winner of the Round Top International Festival Concerto Competition, the New England Philharmonic Young Artists Competition and others, Mr. Ortiz holds an M.M. in Collaborative Piano from The Juilliard School, a B.M. in Piano Performance from The Eastman School of Music, and B.A. in English Literature from the University of Rochester. He is a 2005 graduate of Phillips Academy in Andover, Mass. Mr. Ortiz performs frequently around New York City and is currently working at the Juilliard School as a studio pianist and teaching assistant.

IVAN MOROZOV

Ivan Morozov is a Russian clarinetist who began playing clarinet at age 10 during his time in New York. Morozov has since participated in the Salute to Music program, Juilliard's Music Advancement and Precollege programs, among other programs and events.

He attends the Fiorello H. LaGuardia High School of the Arts.

Morozov is also a self-taught pianist and composer of romantic music. He enjoys studying advanced mathematics and chess.

Joseph Dar court began to study cello at age 10. From age 11, he was a student of John Popham in the Juilliard MAP Program from 2017-19. Since September 2019, he has been under the mentorship of Astrid Schween in Juilliard's pre-college program. Joseph had his Carnegie Hall debut in 2019 at age 12. At that time, he was named the first place winner of the international American Protégé Concerto and Musical Talent competitions. With his spare time, Joseph has created the "M&M/Music and Meditation" project, combining his own "Thank You Breathing Meditation" and classical music.
